ARTICLE IV, DUES

SECTION 1. Upon recommendation of the Board of Directors, the amount of the annual C.A.T.O.E. dues shall be set, with the approval of the membership at a business meeting.

SECTION 2. Dues shall cover the period of January 1 through December 31.

SECTION 3. New members approved prior to October 1, shall be liable for the current year dues; those approved after this date shall be liable for dues beginning January 1 of the following year, and shall enjoy full membership privileges.

SECTION 4. Dues must be paid by January 1 or membership will lapse. If delinquent dues are paid by March 1, full membership will be restored. During membership lapse, voting at meetings is forfeited. After March 1, reinstatement is by action of the Board of Directors.
