Hello Everyone

It has come to our attention that there are rumors suggesting CATOE is "dead" or "defunct". These rumors are **not** accurate! More on that below.....

An article published on May 23, 2025, in the Daily Herald by Dave Heun discussed the repairs and upgrades needed for the organ in the Arcada Theatre, titled "**Historic Arcada Theatre organ getting repairs and upgrades**". Dave contacted me to discuss the current status and future plans for restoring the organ. The article also included comments from Ron Onesti, the promoter for the theatre, and Curtis Hurst, the owner, about the necessary steps before work on the organ can commence. Specifically, installing the lift and providing power to the blowers. According to Onesti and Hurst, the lift should arrive at the theatre in about a month. The process of installing, wiring, and voicing the organ will take approximately a year, with the goal of having it ready for the 100th Anniversary/Birthday celebration in September 2026.
Assistance by our membership will be needed once we receive approval to proceed.

Back to the "rumors"! While we would like to host social events for our members, financial constraints currently limit us to one or two socials per year. If we hold an event at Downers Grove North HS or Mundelein, we can only afford one social annually due to the fees that they charge us – and no it is not for rental of the auditorium, but costs for people on site and port-a-potties. As
