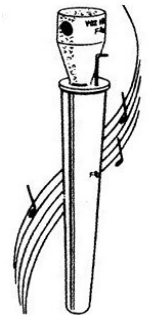

soon! And we are also working on a permanent location for the Oriental Wurlitzer Console—that will get used on a regular basis! More coming up

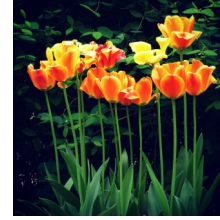
